

# Martha's Illness Exclusion Policy

## Exclude If:



1. Temperature of 100°F orally, 101°F rectally or 99° F axillary or higher.
2. Temperature of 100°F orally, 101°F rectally or 99°F axillary or higher plus one of the following:
  - a) severe cold with yellow-green nasal discharge
  - b) cough
  - c) sore throat
  - d) sneezing
  - e) swollen glands, or skin rash other than mild diaper rash.
3. Red, watery or draining eye(s).
4. Drainage from the ear(s).
5. Lice
6. Skin lesions i.e. impetigo, ringworm and scabies.
7. Vomiting, upset stomach-more than usual infant "spitting up".
8. Diarrhea (is two or more loose watery stools per day for two consecutive days).
9. Fainting or seizures or general signs of listlessness, weakness, drowsiness, flushed face, headache or stiff neck.
10. Fever with any specific signs and symptoms of a communicable disease to which the child has been exposed.



## Re-Admit If:



1. Free of fever for 24 hours.
2. a) Free of fever for 24 hours and  
b) Note is required from a physician stating that the child is not communicable.
3. All discharge from the eye(s) has ceased.
4. a) All drainage from the ear(s) has ceased, or  
b) Note is required from a physician stating that the child is not communicable.
5. After treatment, free of lice and nits.
6. a) Skin sores are healed or  
b) Note from a physician is required stating that the child is not communicable.
7. Free of upset stomach and vomiting for 24 hours.
8. Free of diarrhea for 24 hours.
9. a) Free of symptoms or  
b) Note is required from a physician stating that the child is not communicable.
10. Free of fever for 24 hours
